Motion by resolution Timm, seconded Ott that the township of Caledonia will levy the maximum authorized millage rate allowed by law for the tax year 2014. Vote 5 Ayes, 0 Nays - Carried. Motion Thornton, seconded Hubbard that we sign contracts with Hubbard Lake Community Association (\$50,425.00) and Sanborn Township (\$2800.00) for fire protection during 2014-15. Carried Motion Ott, seconded Scott to contract with Alcona County Humane Society (\$600) for animal control within the township. Carried.

Board will continue with contract from April 2012 for Poverty Exemption Tax Guidelines. Also board agrees to continue contract with American Red Cross (Facility Agreement). Attorney Brian Harger didn't submit his contract renewal until December 2013, but it should be renewed at start of each fiscal year. He will be contacted to get back on track.
